Notification for admissions for 2018-19

Applications are invited from the eligible students in the following Oriental degree colleges;

1. SRI VENKATESWARA ORIENTAL COLLEGE, TIRUPATI.

- The above colleges are functioning in their own permanent buildings with sufficient accommodation for classes, Computer lab & Library Etc.

Important :

- Candidates shall apply through www.admissions.tirumala.org only
- Candidates must submit the hard copy of online filled application along with Photostat copies of relevant certificates on or before the date mentioned above
- Candidates must physically present at counseling center on specified dates along with necessary hard copy of the online filled application and all relevant original certificates.
- Candidate shall pay the prescribed Fees at the time of counseling.

A. Eligibility for Admission: Applicants should have passed the examination of Board of Intermediate Education of A.P & SSC Examination or any other equivalent examination recognized by S.V. University or central Board.

B. Admission procedure: Students will be admitted based on the marks secured in qualifying examination duly following the Rule of Reservation for local, SC, ST, BC, NCC and Sports candidates as prescribed by the Govt.

- 1) Candidates claiming reservation under NCC quota shall produce certificate issued by respective competent authority.
- 2) Candidates claiming reservation under sports quota shall produce a certificate issued by respective competent authority.
- 3) Candidates claiming reservation under Disabled quota shall produce a certificate issued by Govt medical board with >40% disability
- 4) Candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/BC quota shall produce a caste certificate issued by the Tahsildar of concerned mandal
- 5) Candidates claiming reimbursement of fee shall produce an Income certificate issued by the Tahsildar of concerned mandal within one year
- 6) In case of equal marks by the candidates the following order of preference will be followed;
 - a. Passing the qualifying examination in a single attempt.
 - b. Marks secured in Group subjects.
 - c. Then age of the candidate

C. Local candidates : Students studied in Institutions located in the districts of YSR Kadapa, Kurnool, Anantapur , Chittoor and Nellore are treated as local candidates for admission into TTD colleges at Tirupati. Students shall submit the certificate to that effect.

D. Procedure for filing the application for admission

- 1) Candidates must submit their application only in online through web portal <http://admission.tirumala.org>
- 2) Candidates shall enter into <http://admission.tirumala.org> and shall fill all the columns in the web page. The columns with (*) are to be filled compulsorily failing which application will not be considered. Only after filling up of all columns, the candidate shall enter the submit and note down the ID number of the application.
- 3) Candidates shall carefully enter their choice of groups and colleges while filling the online application. The columns in the application cannot be edited after submit button is entered
- 4) Candidates shall download their online filled application by using the ID number and shall submit the printout of it, along with Photostat copies of the specified certificates, while attending to counseling.
- 5) The copies of the following certificates shall be enclosed with the hard copy of application
 - (i) SSC marks memo
 - (ii) Intermediate marks memo & Pre-Degree Marks Memo
 - (iii) Study certificates from class VI to Intermediate
 - (iv) Residence Certificate issued by MRO, who has not studied in educational institute
 - (v) Caste certificate issued by MRO, if claiming reservation

- (vi) Income certificate issued by MRO, if claiming fee reimbursement
- (vii) Disability certificate, if claiming reservation under this category
- (viii) Sports certificates, if claiming reservation under this category
- (ix) NCC certificates, if claiming reservation under this category
- (x) Xerox Copies of Adhar cards of the candidate and parents

E. Counseling for admission :

All eligible applicants will be called for counseling for admission

The dates of counseling will be informed through website <http://admission.tirumala.org> only

The candidates shall download their intimation card and attend the counseling along with the printout of it

The seats will be allotted as per the merit order and reservations

The candidates who fails to attend the counseling will not be given admission.

The candidates shall submit the all certificates shown at D(5), in original at the counseling counters.

The candidates who fails to submit required certificates in original will not be given admission.

F. Courses offered & Fees

Degree (3 Years) duration consisting of two parts; Part-I is compulsory and common to all the course in the first and the Second years of study. The details are as follows:

(1) The students who passed qualifying examination with any combination are eligible for admission into B.A.(Oriental Language), (Telugu/Hindi/Sanskrit).

G. Helpline Desk

H. FEE CONCESSIONS

1. All students of SC and ST Communities whose parental Income does not exceed Rs.1,00,000/- per annum, are **exempted from payment of tuition fee and special fees** subject to the product of the latest Caste and Income Certificate from the MRO concerned.
2. Visually Challenged students are **exempted from payment of College fee such as tuition fee and examination fee.**
3. Children of the TTD Employees are **exempted from payment of the tuition fee only. They have to pay special fees and other fee,** only after production of employment certificate of their parents.
4. The Principal may recommend poor and deserving students for the concessions offered by the State Government and Central Government.

NOTE : If the scholarship is not sanctioned by the concerned welfare department / or not applied by the student, The student has to pay full fee for claiming their TC/CC (Except Visually Challenged students only) The College Management will not be responsible for not claiming the Scholarship.

I. Reservation

Seats are reserved for SC, ST and BC candidates as per the reservation rules. Seats are also reserved as per the reservation rules for the candidates under the categories NCC, Physically Challenged, Visually Challenged, Sports & Games and Children of Armed Personnel. Further, a few seats are reserved for the children of TTD employees in Service.

J. Intimation to selected candidates

1. Interview card to the selected candidate will be sent through post. The information to the selected candidates will also be communicated through SMS, E-mail and the information will be posted on the website: www.admission.tirumala.org. The candidate must present any of the above as evidence of selection during the admission interview.
2. The candidate may also download the Selection / Intimation letter duly referring admission ID.

K. Certificates / Documents to be submitted

Candidates are directed to attend the interviews with the following original certificates and a set of attested Xerox copies.

1. SSC pass certificate cum Marks Memorandum & Intermediate certificate of Equivalent Examinations.
2. Transfer certificate.
3. Candidates who have studied in the state A.P.,
 - a) Study / bonafied certificate from IV to SSC shall be submitted.
 - b) A candidate who has not studied a class in any institution, a Residence certificate for that period only shall be submitted.
 - c) Candidates who have not studied in any School but resided in local area residence certificate mentioning the period of residence from IV to SSC.
4. Permanent Caste certificate of the candidate issued by MRO and latest income certificate of the parent issued by MRO.
5. NCC/ PH/VH/ Sports / Ex-Ser certificates issued by the respective competent authority.
6. Xerox Copies of Aadhar cards of the candidate and parents have to be submitted.
7. The Candidates are informed that they have to pay the FEE on the day of admission itself. If the candidate fails to pay the Fee, the seat will be cancelled automatically without any notice.
8. The Candidates must attend in person and produce the original documents listed below along with 3 sets of Xerox copies duly attested at the time of interview to be conducted on a specified date and time, failing which she / he will not be considered for admission. If the admission is offered, she/ he shall pay the fees immediately failing which she / he will forfeit the seat. The next candidate in the merit list will be considered for admission. ORIGINALS SHOULD BE PRODUCED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION.
9. Fee once paid will not be refunded at any circumstances.

10. The candidate shall attend for interview on the prescribed date in the college to which he / she is selected for admission (As per the Selection / Intimation letter).

L. Instructions to the candidates while filling the application form online

- a) Candidates have to read the prospectus carefully before online submission of application form.
- b) Admission is made on the basis of marks secured in the qualifying examination and also following the rule of reservation.
- c) The candidate has to first decide the college and the groups in the order of their preference before submitting the application in on-line.
- d) The candidate shall exercise option carefully while choosing the college, course(s) and group(s).
- e) The candidate is informed to exercise option to as many eligible groups as possible to get seat in any group.
- f) It is mandatory to fill all the boxes given in the online application before submitting it online otherwise it will be treated invalid.
- g) The candidate has to provide the AAdhar Card number of self and the parents, in the online application, for the purpose of government fee reimbursement. (In case both parents are not alive, death certificate issued by competent authority should be produced during admission interview).
- h) No application will be entertained after last date of submission of applications online.
- i) The selected candidate may download the selection / intimation letter from TTD website and bring the same at the time of Interview.

M. Hostels

- i. Limited hostel accommodation is available to the selected candidates. Students who are residing 25 Kilometers away from Tirupati are alone considered for hostel accommodation (Local area certificate along with distance from Tirupati has to be submitted) the hostel fee should be paid at the time of admission failing which the seat will be cancelled.
- ii. Getting seat into College mean that Hostel seat is allotted.
- iii. Hostel facility is available to Boy's & Girls's candidates selected for admission in S.V.Oriental College, Tirupati.
- iv. Students belonging to other than Hindu religion will not be admitted into hostels.
- v. Students who got admission into hostel shall pay caution deposit of Rs.1500/- and establishment charges Rs.1500/- at the counseling center itself, failing which the seat allotted in the hostel will automatically be cancelled
