Applications are invited from the eligible students in the following degree colleges;

1. Sri Padmavathi Degree College, Tirupati
2. Sri Venkateswara Arts College, Tirupati
3. Sri Govinda Raja Swamy Arts College Tirupati

- All the above colleges are functioning in their own permanent buildings with sufficient accommodation for classes, laboratories, auditorium Etc.
- An unique program for development of employable skills in graduating students is being implemented in above colleges in coordination with the Art of Living of Bangalore and NSDC Certificate will be issued.

Important :

- **Candidates shall apply through www.admissions.tirumala.org only**
 - Candidates must physically present at counseling center on specified dates duly downloading their online filled application by using ID Numbers with all relevant original certificates along with two sets of Photostat copies of relevant certificates.
 - Mere application and attending to the counseling does not confer any right for admission.
 - Candidate shall pay the prescribed Fees at the time of counseling.
- A. Eligibility for Admission:** Applicants should have passed the examination of Board of Intermediate Education of A.P or any other equivalent examination recognized by S.V. University or central Board.
- B. Admission procedure:** Students will be admitted based on the marks secured in qualifying examination duly following the Rule of Reservation for local, SC, ST, BC, NCC, P.H., Ex-Service and Sports candidates as prescribed by the Govt.
- 1) Candidates claiming reservation under NCC quota shall produce **B, C** certificate issued by **Commanding Officer, NCC**.
 - 2) Candidates claiming reservation under sports quota shall produce a certificate of securing places issued by International / National / State authorities in various Games & Sports disciplines.
 - 3) Candidates claiming reservation under Disabled quota shall produce a certificate issued by Govt medical board with >40% disability
 - 4) Candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/BC quota shall produce a caste certificate issued not later than 6 months / Permanantby the M.R.O. / Tahsildar of concerned Mandal
 - 5) Candidates claiming reimbursement of fee shall produce an Income certificate issued by the M.R.O. / Tahsildar of concerned Mandal within one year
 - 6) In case of equal marks by the candidates the following order of preference will be followed;
 - a. Passing the qualifying examination in a single attempt.
 - b. Marks secured in Group subjects.
 - c. Then age of the candidate

C. Local candidates : Students studied in Institutions located in the districts of YSR Kadapa, Kurnool, Anantapur , Chittoor and Nellore are treated as local candidates for admission into TTD colleges at Tirupati. Students shall submit the certificate to that effect.

D. Procedure for filing the application for admission

- 1) Candidates must submit their application only in online through web portal <http://admission.tirumala.org>
- 2) Candidates shall enter into <http://admission.tirumala.org> and shall fill all the columns in the web page. The columns with (*) are to be filled compulsorily failing which application will not be considered. Only after filling up of all columns, the candidate shall enter the submit and note down the ID number of the application.
- 3) Candidates shall carefully enter their choice of groups and colleges while filling the online application. The columns in the application cannot be edited after submit button is entered
- 4) The two sets of following certificates shall be submitted at the time of Counseling with the hard copy of application
 - (i) Intermediate marks memo
 - (ii) SSC marks memo
 - (iii) Study certificates from class VI to Intermediate
 - (iv) Residence Certificate issued by MRO, who has not studied in educational institute
 - (v) Caste certificate issued by MRO, if claiming reservation.
 - (vi) Income certificate issued by MRO, if claiming fee reimbursement
 - (vii) Disability certificate, if claiming reservation under this category
 - (viii) Sports certificates, if claiming reservation under this category
 - (ix) NCC certificates, if claiming reservation under this category
 - (x) Xerox Copies of Adhar cards of the candidate and parents

E. Helpline Desk : A helpline desk is setup at SV Arts College, SGS Arts College and SPW Degree College to provide guidance to the students and their parents. This help desk will work on all working days from 10.00 AM to 5.00 PM.

F. Counseling for admission :

All eligible applicants will be called for a counseling for admission

The dates of counseling will be informed through website <http://admission.tirumala.org> only

The candidates shall download their intimation card and attend the counseling along with the printout of it

The seats will be allotted as per the merit order and reservations

The candidates who fails to attend the counseling will not be given admission.

The candidates who fails to submit required certificates in original will not be given admission.

G. Courses offered & Fees

Each Degree course is of three year duration consisting of two parts; Part-I is compulsory and common to all the course in the first and the Second years of study. The details are as follows:

b) Telugu / Hindi / Sanskrit

Note:

- (1) The students who passed qualifying examination with any combination are eligible for admission into B.A. & B.Com. However students of Arts with history combination will be given priority for admission into B.A(HEP) combination. Students of HTC & HET are preferred for admission into B.A (HPT). Students of Commerce are preferred for admission into B.Com course. Candidates who have studied in Telugu Medium are also eligible for admission into English Medium.
- (2) Students who have passed Vocational courses should have passed bridge course for admission into the respective science group (BSc).

H. Fee structure & Concessions

- 1) The students, whose parents annual income is less than Rs.2.00 Lakhs in case of SCs & STs and Rs.1.00 Lakh in case of others, are eligible for reimbursement of Tuition Fee by the Govt of AP, subject to production of latest income certificate issued by the MRO
- 2) Children of the TTD Employees are exempted from payment of Tuition Fee only. They have to pay Special Fees and other fee, only after production of employment certificate of their parents.
- 3) The prescribed Fees and Caution Deposits shall pay by the student immediately at the counseling center itself on allotment of seat, failing which the seat allotted to him will go to some other who is in the line
- 4) Fee once paid will not be refunded.

I. Hostels:-

- i. Limited hostel accommodation is available to the selected candidates. Students who are residing at 25 Kilometers away

from Tirupati are alone considered for admission into hostel (Local area certificate along with distance from Tirupati has to be submitted)

- ii. Hostel facility is not available to women candidates selected for admission in S.V. Arts College, Tirupati and S.G.S. Arts College, Tirupati.
- iii. Getting seat in the College does not confer the right for admission into hostel.
- iv. Students belonging to other than Hindu religion will not be admitted into hostels.
- v. Students who got admission into hostel shall pay caution deposit of Rs.1500/- and establishment charges Rs.1500/- at the counseling centre itself, failing which the seat allotted in the hostel will automatically be cancelled
